What is Gas Safe Register?

Gas Safe Register is the official list of gas engineers who are qualified to work safely and legally on gas appliances. By law, all gas engineers must be on the Gas Safe Register. It has replaced CORGI registration.

Gas Safe Register is there to help keep you and your family safe. Badly fitted and poorly serviced gas appliances can cause gas leaks, fires, explosions and carbon monoxide poisoning. Only use a Gas Safe registered engineer to fit, fix or service your gas appliances.

What is a Gas Safe registered engineer?

Anyone working on gas must be Gas Safe registered. A Gas Safe registered engineer is qualified to work safely and legally with gas. We make sure more than 123,000 engineers on the Register are safe and undertake inspections on gas work they have carried out. Engineers also have to renew their qualifications regularly to ensure they are up-to-date with industry changes and new technology.

How do I find a Gas Safe registered engineer?

All Gas Safe registered engineers are listed on our website www.GasSafeRegister.co.uk. You can also call **0800 408 5500** and our advisors will help you find an engineer in your area.

To check an engineer is registered every engineer carries a Gas Safe Register ID card, with their own unique licence number. Before any gas work is carried out always ask for the engineer's ID card and check they are qualified for the work you need doing.
